

Historical Development

- In 1981, AID had 1, 789 churches and a membership of 320,924.
- After about 22 years (in 2002), the membership had increased to 1,521,307, and the number of churches had grown to 5,311.
- Other parts of the Church in Africa had also grown greatly.

- So, on October 8, 2002, the Annual Council of the General Conference Executive Committee voted to authorize, effective January 1, 2003, the realignment of territory in Africa and surrounding island nations into three divisions:
 - **≻**East-Central Africa Division (ECD)
 - > Southern Africa-Indian Ocean Division (SID)
 - **>Western Africa Division (WAD)**

- As of June 2003,
 - ➤ East-Central Africa Division (ECD) had a membership of 2,012,030;
 - Southern Africa-Indian Ocean Division (SID) had a membership of 1,569,033, and
 - >West-Central Africa Division (WAD) had 669,620 members.



GROWTH PERCENTAGE 2013-2023























WEST-CENTRAL AFRICA DIVISION Statistical Report Summary Baptism 2013-2023




WEST-CENTRAL AFRICA DIVISION Statistical Report Summary Death 2013-2023
